Language requirements (EU self-assessment grid/IELTS/TOEFL)

English language proficiency can be demonstrated by a language of instruction certificate or a standardised language test.

IELTS: An overall mark of 6.5 and no section below 5.5

TOEFL (paper based): A score of 4.5 in a written test and a total score of 575

TOEFL (internet based): A score of 20 in a written test and a total score of 90

TOEIC: An overall mark of 775
